Collaboration and Partnerships in Addressing issues of migrants during the Pandemic

- Access to services and humanitarian support irrespective of migratory status
- Amnesty procedures or extension of validity of visa and regularisation of all migrant workers
- Return and reintegration process must be humane and rights-based
- Return or repatriation processes must establish and maintain standard operating procedures in place to ensure that all migrant workers are able to safely return without exclusion or discrimination,





Collaboration and Partnerships in Building Back Better

- Justice for Wage theft
 - Countries of Destination and Origin create mechanisms to document migrant grievances prior to repatriation
 - Countries of origin to set-up mechanisms during return and quarantine of migrants to document grievances of migrants in particular wage theft
 - Setting up of an urgent justice mechanism to address grievances of repatriated migrant workers

Advancing Fair and Ethical Recruitment Post COVID-19

- Advancing Fair and Ethical Recruitment Post COVID-19:
 - Zero recruitment fees for migrants and employer pays model
 - Quarantine and testing costs should not be paid by migrant workers
 - Access to health care, testing and treatment should be made available for migrant workers
- Guidelines for deployment and recruitment of migrants post covid-19 should align with the ILO Fair recruitment agenda and guidelines developed by ILO and IOM for business and private recruitment agencies
